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Position Summary:

Offer golfers mobile food and beverage service on course.
Assist in supplying stock and maintaining cleanliness of the Turnstand

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide food and beverage service to golfers on the course in accordance with the food and beverage menu and company quality standards
- Follow proper cash handling procedures for each transaction, including end of day sales report
- Requisition supplies from kitchen and storeroom, and ensure proper transfer of product
- Consistently inventory in and out product each shift, to be returned with supervisor signature
- Comply with applicable health, alcoholic beverage, fire and other laws/requirements
- Regularly inspect equipment, report any concerns or malfunctions to supervisor
- Perform other duties as appropriate

Qualifications:

- High school preferred
- One (1) year applicable functional, experience, preferably in the golf industry.
- Demonstrated quality interpersonal communication skills
- Ability to analyze and solve problems; efficiently handle multiple duties under pressure with minimal supervision; work flexible hours as required including evenings/weekends
- Positive attitude, professional manner and appearance in all situations

Classification:

Part-time, Seasonal or Non-Seasonal, Hourly, Non-Exempt

Working Conditions:

Work hours may include days and evenings on weekdays and weekends. Work primarily outdoors in a restaurant/golf course environment, with some indoor work involving restaurant, and bar service. Will be exposed to sharp utensils, extremely hot stoves and grills, sharp and rapid equipment movements, hot food, potentially dangerous chemicals and solvents daily. May be exposed, from time to time, to inclement weather, potentially dangerous pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, equipment movement hazards, and misdirected golf balls. Injury may result as a result of exposure to the above if safety policies and practices are not properly

followed at all times.

Cash drawer and iPad/Square credit card processor

Physical Requirements:

Possess ability to:

- Read and write (English)
- Communicate verbally with staff members and/or customers with or without the use of two-way radios.
- Give and/or follow verbal and written instructions
- Visually inspect all work areas
- Operate equipment for several hours at a time
- Perform mathematical calculations involving fractions, decimals, and percentages
- Stand, sit, walk, push, pull, lift, grasp, bend and kneel for up to 5 hours at a time
- Lift to 50 lbs. occasionally, 30 lbs. frequently, and 10 lbs. constantly
